

HORTON IN RIBBLESDALE PARISH COUNCIL

CAR PARK POLICY – Adopted 12th July 2021

Introduction

Horton in Ribblesdale Parish Council has made provision for a free car park at Helwith Bridge and this policy includes regulations for the safe use of the car park for residents and visitors.

Regulations

- Free parking for the use of residents & visitors on a first served basis.
- No Access to the car park for vehicles that cannot pass under the height barrier without prior permission from the Parish Council.
- The car park must not be used for camping purposes including the overnight sleeping in vehicles.
- No maintenance work to be undertaken on vehicles beyond that needed to start the vehicle.
- Parking is not permitted for unroadworthy, SORN, untaxed, non MOT, or abandoned vehicles.
- When parking please avoid obstructing other vehicles.
- Avoid causing noise nuisance or driving at an inappropriate speed.
- Avoid anti-social and criminal behaviour.
